COVID RESTRICTIONS:

We will follow guidelines for Covid as posted by the ACBL at tournament time. These are current guidelines, but they may change before the tournament.

- (1) All staff, volunteers and players must be fully vaccinated no less than 14 days before the date of the event in which the player wishes to buy an entry. (Proof of vaccination is required.) Boosters HIGHLY recommended but not required. (If you do not play at the Indianapolis Bridge Center with a proof of vaccination on record, please be sure to bring proof with you.)
- (2) Masks are not required if the Covid-19 Community Level is medium or low. Masks are recommended for those at high risk for severe illness. If a player who is high-risk asks for tablemates to wear masks, masks will be required at the table. (Please bring a mask with you as a back-up in case a player asks for tablemates to be masked.)
- (3) Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the playing area.

FOOD:

- ◆ FREE packaged snacks, coffee, and bottled water will be available during tournament.
- ◆ At lunchtime, you may bring your lunch and eat-in, or you may go out to nearby restaurants. Restaurant information will be available on-site.
